#### Nevada 2020

The Childhood Bereavement Estimation Model (CBEM)<sup>1</sup> approximates rates of U.S. children and youth who will experience the death of a parent or sibling by the time they reach adulthood. Results from the CBEM are updated annually using national, state, and regional vital statistics.<sup>2</sup> Except where noted, this report uses data from 2014-2018 in an enhanced framework to present projected CBEM\* results.





### Death of a Sibling & Death of a Parent


The CBEM provides separate, independent estimates for youth who will experience the death of a parent or the death of a sibling.
